Reminder that members cannot enter BOTH W/T and all-gait classes in one discipline; however, they can enter W/T in one discipline, i.e. Stock Seat, and all gaits in another, i.e. Hunt Seat.

EDUCATIONAL DAY ACTIVITIES <u>MUST</u> be signed up for on the Clark County Fair Entry Form. If a member is not signed up by the end of June on the entry form, they will not be able to participate in educational day activities.

PARKING/VET-CHECK DUTIES: Kaileigh will have volunteer sign-up sheets available next meeting. Reminder - all clubs are required to do 2 shifts of parking and 2 shifts of vet-check duties at the fair. If you do not sign up, Kaileigh will select dates/times for your club.

CCF RIBBONS: Ribbons will be handed out at a table in envelopes like done at pre-fair
